National Symbols

TITLE 03 — NATIONAL SYMBOLS · CHAPTER 01 — SYMBOLS OF STATE

- 1 The State shall have national symbols representing the Crown, the State, and the Kaharagian Nation.
- 2 The national symbols of Kaharagia are:
 - a. the flags of the State, including the Standard of the Sovereign, the National Flag, the Civil Flag, the State Flag, the Cultural Flag, and the Banner of the Royal House
 - b. the Coat of Arms, in its lawful forms
 - c. the Great Seal and other seals of State
 - d. the motto
 - e. the anthem
 - f. such other symbols as the Sovereign may designate.
- 3 The form, specification, and protocol for the use of each national symbol shall be determined by Sovereign Decree and recorded in the registers of State.
- 4 The Sovereign may regulate and protect national symbols, including by restricting official use and by prohibiting falsification, counterfeiting, or misleading use, as provided by law.
