# Temporary Nature

## TITLE 09 — EXTRAORDINARY MEASURES · CHAPTER 01 — EMERGENCY POWERS

- 1 Extraordinary measures shall be proportionate to the circumstances and remain subject to modification or revocation by the Sovereign.
- 2 Unless renewed, extraordinary measures lapse upon the expiry stated in the measure or upon the cessation of the emergency grounds, whichever occurs first.
- 3 The Sovereign may require periodic review and reporting by ministers or organs concerning the continued necessity of extraordinary measures.
- 4 Acts performed under extraordinary measures remain valid notwithstanding later revocation, unless the measure or subsequent law provides otherwise.
- 5 Compensation or relief for burdens imposed by extraordinary measures may be provided by law or by Sovereign Decree.
