Purpose of Authority

TITLE 01 — THE STATE AND THE NATION · CHAPTER 03 — SOVEREIGNTY AND SUPREMACY

- 1 Sovereign authority shall be exercised for the preservation of order, justice, continuity of the State, and the welfare of the Kaharagian Nation.
- 2 In exercising public authority, organs of the State shall act for proper purposes, in good faith, and in a manner consistent with the dignity of the Crown.
- 3 Public authority shall be exercised according to law; where the law is silent, the general principles of Kaharagian public order declared by the Sovereign shall apply.
- 4 Measures taken under public authority shall be proportionate to their lawful ends.
- 5 Nothing in this Article creates a cause of action against the person of the Sovereign.
